SCHOOL OF MINISTRY 2 Year Scope and Sequence



Class 1 - Gospel-Empowered Ministry [Created by Resonate Church]

An overview of an approach to ministry that rests personal transformation and missional multiplication solely on the finished work of Jesus Christ. This course will cover understanding the gospel, its implications, and how a gospel culture is created in a local church.

Class 2 - Effective Communication [CLP3440]

An introduction to effective communication for ministry and leadership. This course will cover understanding the art of communication along with engagement and practice implementing important skills to improve conversations.

Class 3 - Ministry Leadership [CLE1312]

An introduction to the basic principles and methods of leadership. Unique aspects of biblical leadership as applied to church, para-church organizations, and denomination will be explored. Current resources and techniques are examined.

Class 4 - Making Disciples [CLE2371]

This course explores the process of spiritual development as well as methods of discipleship practiced in the church. Students will examine the biblical backgrounds of discipleship and the role of spiritual disciplines, community, development of spiritual gifts, and accountability in spiritual growth.

Class 5 - Introduction to Church Planting [CLI1313]

An intensive study of the essential aspects of church planting. Major attention will be given to theology, methodologies, and models of new church starts, with emphasis on continuing growth and missional advancement.

Class 6 - Christian Theology I [CLL1211]

An introduction to Christian theology focusing on its nature, task, method, and application followed by a survey of the doctrines of Revelation, the Triune God, Creation, Humanity, and Sin.

Class 7 - Christian Theology II [CLL1212]

An introduction to Christian theology, surveying the doctrines of Christ, Salvation, the Spirit, the Church, and Eschatology, including an additional focus on the ethical implications of Christian thought and practice.

Class 8 - Principles and Approaches to Bible Teaching [CLE1113]

This course includes a study of the principles and methods of preparation, delivery, and evaluation for transformational Bible teaching. The course content includes a discussion of appropriate handling of the text and effective application of biblical principles. Attention will be given to multi-modal teaching and other key issues in effective teaching.

Enrolled students who complete the first four classes will receive a Ministry Essentials certificate. Enrolled students who complete all eight classes will receive a Ministry Essentials diploma.
